### SUBMISSION INFORMATION

## Artwork accepted for exhibition must conform to these guidelines:

- Applicant must be a current high school student living in Maryland's 8th District.
- Each entry must be original in concept, design, and execution and may not violate U.S. copyright laws.
- Artwork must adhere to the policy of the House Office Building Commission. In accordance with this policy, exhibits depicting subjects of contemporary political controversy or a sensationalistic or gruesome nature are not allowed.
- Artwork must be two-dimensional.
- Accepted mediums for the two-dimensional artwork are as follows:
  - o Paintings: oil, acrylics, watercolor, etc.
  - Drawings: colored pencil, pencil, ink, marker, pastels, charcoal (it is recommended that charcoal and pastel drawings be fixed)
  - o Prints: lithographs, silk screen, block prints
  - Mixed Media: use of more than two mediums such as pencil, ink, watercolor, etc.
  - Collages (must be two dimensional)
  - Computer-generated art
  - o Photographs
- Artwork submitted for exhibition MUST be accompanied by a completed <u>Student Information & Release Form</u> which can be found online at: <a href="https://raskin.house.gov/sites/raskin.house.gov/files/art%20release%202019">https://raskin.house.gov/sites/raskin.house.gov/files/art%20release%202019</a> %20%281%29.pdf
  - "Completed" means the form must include all requested information and <u>signatures from student</u>, <u>parent/guardian and art</u> teacher.
- Work entered must be in the original medium (that is, not a scanned reproduction of a painting or drawing).
- Artwork can be no larger than 26 inches high, 26 inches wide, and 4 inches in depth and must not weigh more than 15 pounds when framed.

 Artwork must be enhanced and protected by a sturdy frame and wired for hanging.

# **SUBMISSION INFORMATION (continued)**

## Artwork accepted for exhibition must conform to these guidelines:

- Frames must be made of wood or metal. Please do not use plastic "snap on" frames or metal frames that can easily break.
- Two sturdy eye hooks or the equivalent must be attached at the top right and left sides of the back of the frame for hanging to prevent the work from leaning forward or hanging unevenly. Place wire between the hooks for hanging at the district exhibition.
- Please indicate which side is 'up' by marking arrows pointing towards the top on the back.
- Using the largest label you have available, type this information and securely apply to the back of the piece:

- All artwork, except paintings in oil or acrylic on canvas, must be protected by Plexiglas or glass. Plexiglas is preferred.
