

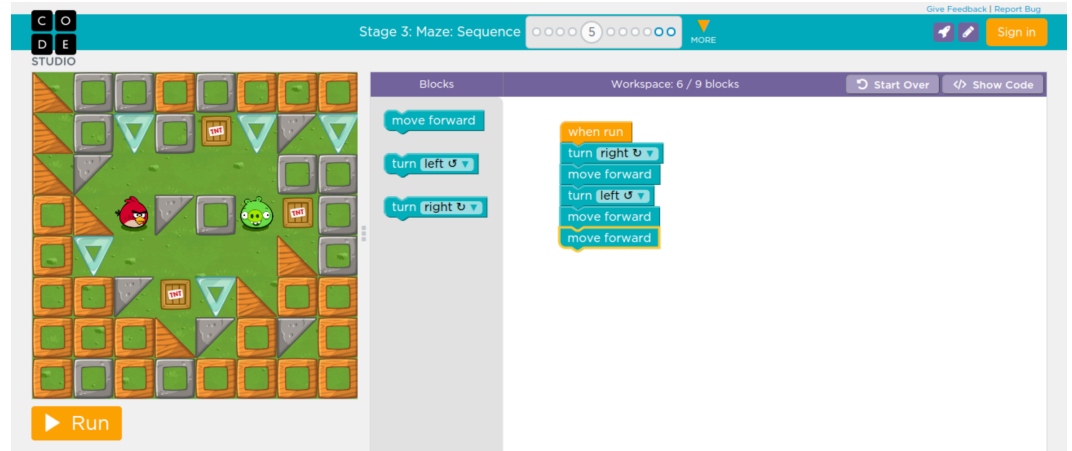
Coding Club

What is Coding Club?

North Frederick Elementary will offer coding club for 2nd grade students in Sprint 2020! Students will create programs with loops, events, and conditionals. They will translate their initials into binary, investigate different problem-solving techniques, and discuss how to respond to cyberbullying. By the end of the course, students will create interactive games that they can share. Each concept in this course (Code.org curriculum) is taught from the beginning, graduating toward experiences that allow for growth and creativity to provide all students a rich and novel programming experience.

This is a **Friday** club, hosted in the computer lab, from **3pm-4pm** that lasts **18 sessions** (excluding dates when school is closed) from **January 3rd, 2020 – May 15th, 2020** pending sufficient enrollment. Enrollment is tentatively limited to the **first 20 students to sign up**.
