GIRLS SOCCER-

The girl's soccer team recorded an 11-1 regular season with their only defeat coming to Urbana. The Knights would then move into the state tournament and find more success there as they would rattle off three straight one-goal victories to advance into the state semifinals. After exciting playoff games the girls soccer team advanced to the State Championship, where they came up short of the win in a 2-1 loss to Calvert.

GIRLS CROSS COUNTRY-

The girl's cross country team had another banner season as they claimed a number of team and individual awards. The team finished 2nd in the state and Erin McQuitty was able to take home the individual state championship!

GOLF-

The MHS golf team was shy of making states as a team but was able to sent Landon Leatherman. Leatherman represented the Knights well and shot a career best of 78 in the first round of the state tournament. He finished 15th out of 41.

BOYS SOCCER-

The boy's soccer team also picked up some hardware as a successful regular season lead to the Knights clinching the CMC-Gambrill Division with a 6-0-1 record in the Gambrill Divison. Middletown's playoff run would be shortened early as they would lose in the regional semifinal round against Walkersville 2-0.

FIELD HOCKEY-

The field hockey team would find some success during the regular season as they would be the second seed in 2A West-Region I. Unfortunately, Middletown would fall to the Lancers during the first game of the playoffs.

BOYS CROSS COUNTRY-

The boy's cross country team showed promise as one of the Middletown teams with an exceptionally young squad as the Knights would show promise with Zachary Spurrier recording multiple top of the field finishes including a 33rd place finish at regionals.

VOLLEYBALL-

The volleyball team showed some signs of promise as well as an extremely young squad battled hard in their games but could not come up with a playoff victory against Williamsport and ended their season without a win.

FOOTBALL-

The football team made the playoffs for the first time since the 2016-2017 season.
