PE Updates

The theme in P.E. the last few weeks has been underhand throwing. All grade levels have been working to perfect their underhand throwing form. I like to work on this skill for about two weeks with our students as it allows them to have a week of skill practice and become familiar with how to use correct form. The second week allows for more interactive underhand throwing games as a class or in small groups. Following underhand throwing, students will move to focus on the skill of overhand throwing. We will use the same two-week schedule to allow for practice and then gameplay.

The underhand and overhand throwing units are used to help prepare our students for the Magic Club unit that we do in P.E. Magic club is

a progressive throwing and catching unit where students are challenged to use different balls and complete different types of throws in order to "level up". In my experience, students really enjoy Magic Club and keeping track of their own progress in order to gain levels or awards. While Magic Club occurs in grades 3-5, I preview it with a simplified version in grades K-2.

Art Updates

Classes are diving into new learning with grade level vocabulary and concepts. Please be sure your child is dressed appropriately when they have art as we use a variety of media.

PK-1st: Lines, Geometric Shapes2nd: Texture, Neutral Colors

3rd: Rhythm, Value

4th: Tertiary Colors, Positive/Negative Space5th: Subject Matter, Art Elements and Principles

Music Updates

PreK: Students are exploring singing, movement, instruments, and building awareness of personal space.

K and 1st: Students are still learning about musical opposites such as same vs. different, fast vs. slow, high vs. low, long vs. short in addition to steady beat. They will keep developing their voices through songs and exercises. 1st graders will also be introduced to solfege syllables sol and mi.

2nd: Students are exploring the parts of the treble staff by studying solfege syllables do, sol, mi, and la. They continue to develop their voices through singing games.

3rd - 5th: Students will continue to study rhythms they have learned this year. They will learn about expressive elements in music: dynamics (the levels of loud or quiet) and tempo (the levels of fast or slow). Students will also explore major v. minor and expand their knowledge of solfege syllables fa and ti.
