<u>Essential Functions</u>: Under the direction of the Warehouse Foreman or Warehouse Team Leader, the Warehouse Summer Intern moves equipment and furniture, loads and unloads trucks, receives, stores, issues, preserves, inspects, packs and accounts for inventory supplies and equipment.

- Verifies unit of issue, item descriptions, quality and condition according to information shown on ETF (Equipment Transfer Form).
- Loads/unloads trucks and sea containers.
- Segregates damage containers and supplies and notify Foreman or Team Leader immediately.
- Operates Material handling Equipment (MHE) including manual/electric pallet jacks, handcarts, and dollies to load, unload, relocate palletize, and segregate inventory and equipment.
- Packs, crates, stencils, and bands inventory and equipment for shipment or storage.
- Ability to work well with others and as a team.
