CURRICULUM UPDATES

ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

Students will practice their reading and writing skills as we wrap up our school year by writing our favorite first grade memories, questions we have about second grade, and preparing our reading binders for summer practice.

Ways to help your child be ready for second grade reading:

1. Practice, practice, practice those heart words (click [HERE](#) for a printable Heart Word Book)
2. Have your child write about things they do throughout the summer or write creatively.
3. Read regularly with your child.

MATH

We have finished all curricular math lessons and will be focusing on reviewing what we have learned this year.

Ways to help your child be ready for second grade math:

1. Practice addition and subtraction math facts to 20
2. Practice counting, identifying, and writing numbers to 120
3. Review math skills such as comparing numbers, place value (ones and tens), and solving for unknown in different places in an equation ($6 + ? = 10$ $8 - ? = 5$ $7 = ? - 2$)
4. Utilize online math games such as abcya.com (with parental supervision)

SOCIAL STUDIES/PATHS

We will be complete our final health unit on safety. Students will study drug safety and sun and water safety.
