

## **Art Updates**

#### L4L

- Students will create art by subject matter.
- Students will learn about the art subject matter <u>cityscape</u> and create one of their own.

#### PreK

• Students will be learning about the art elements of shape and color.

#### <u>Kindergarten</u>

- Students will be learning about the art element texture.
- Students will learn about Geometric Shapes.
- Students will create seasonal artwork using different art tools & media.

#### **1st Grade**

- Students will learn about the art subject matter portrait.
- Students will review the colors families primary, secondary, warm, and cool.
- Students will experiment with the use of <u>warm</u> and <u>cool colors</u> in their artwork.
- Students will continue to learn about the art principle pattern.

#### 2nd Grade

- Students will learn about the art subject matter <u>cityscape</u>.
- Students will explore and use a variety of <u>art tools</u> and media.
- Students will learn about the art element <u>shape</u> and identifying <u>geometric</u> and <u>organic shapes</u>.

#### 3rd Grade

- Students will learn about <u>perspective</u> and the strategies used to show it in a 2-D work of art.
- Students will practice identifying the <u>foreground</u>, <u>middleground</u>, and background in a work of art.
- Students will learn about the art element of <u>value</u>.

#### 4th Grade

- Students will continue to practice showing their understanding of different art styles.
- Students will create an abstract portrait.
- Students will be introduced to <u>tertiary</u> colors.

#### 5th Grade

- Students will recognize and create art by subject matter.
- Students will continue to recognize and discuss how they are using the art elements and art principles in their artwork.
- Students will explore a variety of <u>art tools</u> and <u>media</u>.

#### **Author Appreciation**

My goal is for all students this year to grow in their enjoyment of quality picture books. So many of the picture books in our library allow students to understand themselves, others, and our world in a more vivid way. Together, we will explore quality children's authors and illustrators (i.e. Eric Carle, Tomie dePaola, Matt De La Pena, etc) and uncover what makes them outstanding contributors to children's literature.

#### **Grades 3-5**

#### Coding

#### Research

Our students have more information at their fingertips than any previous generation did at their age. It is important for students to learn how to distinguish if the information they are consuming is trustworthy. We will use the T.R.A.P.P. method (Trustworthy, Relevance, Authority, Accuracy, and Purpose) to determine the reliability of multiple information sources. We will also learn how to evaluate resources based on their research needs. We will compare and contrast books and databases to determine the most effective information resources for specific research topics.

## Music Updates



#### <u>Kindergarten</u>

 In January, students will explore musical opposites and engage in singing familiar songs and singing games.

#### PreK

• In January, PreK students will explore loud and soft through movement, singing, and playing instruments.

#### Learning for Life

• In January, students will sing, dance, and play a variety of classroom instruments.

#### 1st Grade

- Ms. Gearhart's classes will identify and perform solfege using so, mi, and la.
- Mrs. Slick's classes will be exploring melodic direction through stories and singing activities.

#### **2nd Grade**

- Ms. Gearhart's classes will learn about expressive elements i.e. tempo and dynamics.
- Mrs. Slick's classes will be exploring singing in rounds and completing a Chinese New Year composition project.

#### 3rd Grade

- Ms. Gearhart's classes will learn about expressive elements i.e. tempo and dynamics.
- Mrs. Slick's classes will be composing their own music using notes on the staff- B-A-G.

#### 4th Grade

- Ms. Gearhart's classes will learn about expressive elements i.e. tempo and dynamics.
- Mrs. Slick's classes will compose their own music using notes learned on the treble clef this year and will perform them on melodic instruments.

#### 5th Grade

- Ms. Gearhart's classes will learn about expressive elements i.e. tempo and dynamics.
- Ms. Gearhart's classes will also learn and perform songs on the soprano recorder.
- Mrs. Slick's classes will compose their own music through various activities.
