WHO MAY APPLY: Graduating high school seniors planning to attend an accredited undergraduate college or university, accredited vocational or trade school or community college. To qualify, the student needs to have been accepted into a college or university, accredited vocational or trade school or community college.

CRITERIA: Be a resident of the Johnsville election district or the son/daughter or grandchild of a Johnsville Ruritan Club member.

1. Demonstrate academic achievement--excellence in effort and performance. A high school transcript must be submitted with the application.
2. Demonstrate outstanding service to community and involvement in leadership and extracurricular activities.
3. Clear statement of education goals.
4. Financial need will be considered, but it is not the primary factor in selecting winner.
5. Provide two letters of reference.
6. Complete the application form by the designated time. Neatness will be considered.
No late applications will be accepted
7. The funds will be paid to the institution of education after the successful completion of the first semester and the review of the transcripts.
