Scholarship - New Market District Lions Club

The New Market District Lions Club is sponsoring \$1,000 scholarships for Linganore High School and Oakdale High School graduating seniors who plan to attend Frederick Community College (FCC) during the 2024 – 2025 academic year. Scholarships may be used for tuition, books, lab fees, supplies and other needs directly associated with expenses at FCC.

Scholarships will be awarded by the New Market Lions Club based on the following criteria:

- 1. Applicant's interest in attending FCC as expressed in a written narrative including: student's career plans, courses to be taken and how they will apply to their career choice and the reason the student feels he/she should be awarded a scholarship.
- 2. Student's academic record as reflected in his/her high school transcript through 1st semester of grade 12.
- 3. Three written recommendations two from teachers and one from another person.

Application Procedures

- 1. Applicant must complete the Student Scholarship Application form.
- 2. Applicant must prepare a written statement which includes items requested in #1 above.
- 3. Applicant must include a copy of his/her academic transcript through first semester of senior year with the application materials.
- 4. Applicant must provide verification of enrollment at FCC or other information that indicates intent to enroll at FCC in fall of 2024.
- 5. Applicant must have three (3) references submitted with application, two from Linganore High School or Oakdale High School and/or the Frederick County Career & Technology Center teachers and a third from another person.
- 6. All materials are to be submitted to the Guidance Office to Ms. Lisa Martinazzi at Linganore High School or Ms. Diane Harding at Oakdale High by April 3, 2024.

Each applicant's completed packet of materials will be forwarded to the New Market District Lions Club at the close of school day on April 3, 2024 for evaluation. Scholarship winners and their parents will be invited to attend the Lions Club meeting at the New Market Fire Hall on May 6, 2024 for presentation of the scholarships.
