- Applicant must have been a Varsity Student Athlete for at least 1 season at LHS.
- Applicants must be planning to attend an accredited two (2) year, four (4) year College, University or Trade School during the fall, following graduation.
- Applicants must have at least 1 parent or guardian as a current member of the Linganore High School Sports Boosters.
- Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
