Esperanza's 15-year Anniversary Scholarship Award - Supporting a path through Community College

The Esperanza Education Fund will award scholarships of \$4,000 - \$5,000 to immigrant students in the District of Columbia, Maryland, and Virginia to attend **public community colleges**, regardless of ethnicity, national origin, or immigration status.

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be born outside the United States or have two parents born outside the United States. Must be a graduating high school senior or a recent GED recipient in the District of Columbia, Maryland, or Virginia.
- Must enroll full-time at an accredited public community college in 2024-2025...

Selection Criteria and Process

Scholarship recipients will be selected based on qualities traditionally valued and demonstrated by the immigrant community: hard work, resourcefulness, perseverance in the face of adversity, academic achievement, leadership, and commitment to one's community.
