LOU Redistricting Information

IMPORTANT! A school redistricting study, begun in January 2019, includes ALL Linganore-Oakdale-Urbana area schools. The BOE must establish attendance areas and feeder patterns for new schools in response to FCPS enrollment growth*.

As the decision-making phase begins for the redistricting study, this is a reminder of important dates: Community members continue to play an important role through opportunities to provide feedback to BOE members, attending public hearings, and/or sharing feedback via email to LOURedistrict@fcps.org.
