Free and Reduced Lunch Applications

Free and reduced-price meals are available to families with limited ability to pay. Eligibility is based on family size and income guidelines developed by the U.S. Department of Agriculture.

Meal Benefit Application forms were distributed to students in August. The forms should be filled out completely and returned by families who wish to be considered, although application can be made at any time during the school year. Only one Meal Benefit Application form per family is required. FCPS Food and Nutrition Services will notify families whether they qualify. Student Weapons Possession Policy

Please note FCPS Regulation 200-29 related to student weapon possession and school security. "It is unlawful for students to possess or use any weapon on school property. Students who have or use a weapon on school property will be suspended from school, and the police will be notified of the incident. A weapon is any object designed to harm another physically or an object which is used in a way that can physically harm another. This school is committed to providing each of you with a safe environment, and we will do all we can to carry out that responsibility including, if necessary, conducting searches of student lockers."

Please allow your children to get out of the car and walk into school unassisted. School staff will be sure your child gets to the door safely. If you would like to walk your child in you must park in a spot and walk them in. Also, please do not try to pass other cars in the car rider line as this is a safety risk to other cars and pedestrians. Thank you.
