Close Contact Notification Letter

This notification is provided to any individual in the school building who has been identified as a close contact during the case investigation and contact tracing.

Dear < Parent/Guardian/Employee>:

<You/your child have/has> been identified as a close contact of an individual who has tested positive for COVID-19 and will need to quarantine at home for 10 days due to an exposure to the individual with COVID-19 on COVID-19 on Close Contact>.

Alternatively, if you/your child remain(s) symptom free and gets tested for COVID-19 on day 5 of quarantine or later, and the results are negative, you/they may return after 7 days of quarantine. You will receive follow up phone calls from the School COVID-19 Call Center who will provide support via answering questions and reviewing health monitoring. The timeline below provides the specific dates for the potential quarantine options.

Quarantine Timeline

Please monitor <you/your child's> health during the quarantine period, and call your health care provider and seek COVID-19 testing if you/your child develops any symptoms of COVID-19.

Quarantine means:

- Stay home except to obtain medical care.
- You/Your child may not participate in in-person school activities. Avoid public spaces, and practice physical distancing from other people at all times (6 feet is recommended).
- Wear cloth masks when around other people.

Monitoring means:

• Watch for fever. Check temperature twice a day, at least 6 hours apart and record in a log.

• If <you/your child> or anyone in the household develops symptoms such as a fever, cough, sore throat, difficulty breathing, diarrhea or vomiting, new onset of severe headache, or new loss of taste or smell, contact your healthcare provider immediately.
