


Thank you for contacting Delegate Ciliberti's office regarding scholarship opportunities. Delegate Ciliberti is now accepting applications for his Legislative Scholarship. Please note the following:

- The scholarship is open to students living within Legislative District 4 in Frederick or Carroll Counties.
- In order to qualify for a scholarship, you must create a profile on the Maryland Higher Education Commission (MHEC) website. Awards will be distributed through this system.
- All applications **MUST BE TYPED.**
- All applications must be mailed to our office. We will not accept any applications that are emailed or faxed. All applications must be postmarked no later than **July 23, 2022.**
- If you will be attending a college out-of-state, you must submit a separate 'Unique Major' request directly to MHEC. There are no scholarships available for students who attend an out-of-state institution without declaring a 'Unique Major.'
- In addition to the application form, your application must also include:
 - A copy of your FAFSA Student Aid Report (summary sheet).
 - An Official sealed high school or college transcript.
 - A one-page essay explaining your career goals and why you should receive a scholarship.
