Please note, schedule change requests will be considered only if:

- Your schedule is not a complete schedule (less than 8 credits)
- Your course level is incorrect (ex: Honors vs. On Grade Level)
- You need to repeat a previously failed course that is a <u>prerequisite</u> for another course
- SENIORS only You requested a course but it is missing on your schedule, and it's a graduation requirement
- Improper sequence (example: Spanish 3 before Spanish 2)
