Three \$2,000 Scholarships

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES:

- These scholarships will be awarded to three students attending an accredited college or university pursuing a two-year or four-year program.
- Applicants must be completing their senior year of high school or must be non-traditional students.
- Applicants must reside in the Middletown school district.

APPLICATION TO INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING

- Completed application form.
- A STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL NEED is strongly considered in awarding these scholarships.
- Two recommendations: at least one from academic sources.
- Copy of authorized high school transcript.
- List of participation in community and civic activities in which the applicant has participated.
- List of high school extracurricular activities.
- Field of study and goals.

APPLICATION AVAILABILITY:

- Applications are available on the MHS student's Naviance Account, under the Scholarship Tab.

TIMELINE:

- Completed applications must be sent/submitted by mail to the Middletown Lions Club Scholarship committee no later than **Friday, April 26, 2024.**
