The American Legion 2024 MD Boys State Program will be held at McDaniel College, Westminster, Maryland from June 16 – 22, 2024 (date and location are subject to change). Our program is a Nationally recognized program in leadership, government, and political sciences. Tuition for the program for accepted Boys is fully funded by The American Legion, Department of Maryland Posts and sponsors. We ask that the school counselors make distribution as appropriate of the flyers attached.

<u>Please consider sending this information to Social Science Departments, Student Government Associations, NHS, JROTC, and other areas interested in leadership, governance, and political studies.</u>

The application process is online at www.mdlegion.org/boysstate and may be accessed at any time starting in early November 2023. Any student that may be interested should fill out Boys State application completely on-line. Please feel free to duplicate the flyers or send electronically to parents and students. The schools may also contact us for additional copies of the Flyer. The electronic version can be found at www.mdlegion.org/boysstate. There is a sheet that the young men will print to get Guidance Counselor recommendation (also attached), which they can upload once signed. The local American Legion Posts are still the sponsors for this program, and the students should contact their local American Legion Post to arrange funding. If there is no local American Legion Post, send the completed application to Department Headquarters, 101 N. Gay Street, Room E, Baltimore, Maryland 21202. The program's aim is to expose current high school juniors to the United States Constitutional form of government. The program will emphasize the necessity of their future active participation as a citizen in the government process to insure continuing freedoms and rights.

The experienced instructors at Boys State offer the students an opportunity of a lifetime to immerse themselves into the creation of a government among equal citizens selected from the finest young men in MD high schools. The challenge to create a functioning City and State government allows the young men to focus their talents in areas seldom explored in a normal classroom environment.

Presenters include politicians and elected leaders from the local and State levels of government, and many special interest topics to young adults. Highlights of the week include a trip to the State Emergency Management Agency, sports, and political simulations, along with City, State, and National elections, where 2 young men earn the right to represent MD at Boys Nation in Washington, DC.

The events this year will feature our General Assembly simulation program. This unique program explores the differences between the State Constitution of Maryland and the Federal Constitution, with written source material spotlighting issues of current legislation pending before Congress and the previous State Legislative sessions.

The students are required to work as a team under close supervision. The students are encouraged to produce and create on their own initiative within their assigned political parties as potential leaders and candidates for future elective public office. We consider this a week of learning and group participation. The experiences gained at Boys State stay with the student their whole life.

Enclosed is a handbook from a previous year's program for your reference. A sample handbook and more resources are located at our website www.mdlegion.org/boysstate.

The need to obtain a college education to compete in the modern world with changing technologies is emphasized by our guest speakers. Boys State is an excellent addition to any college application and is a highly coveted entry on applications to Service Academies.

Attendees at MD Boys State have 2 exciting opportunities offered by McDaniel College. For a small fee (rate for 2024 to be determined) any graduate of MD Boys State can receive 2 College Credits for the week from McDaniel College by completing a few requirements in addition to full attendance and participation at MD Boys State. Also, McDaniel College is offering MD Boys State 2024 graduates that are accepted and enroll in McDaniel for the Fall 2025 semester \$10,000 per year (\$40,000) for four years in scholarship funds. See the attached flyer for more information.

Boys who attend in 2024 and meet the requirements may apply for the Samsung Scholarship grant, which last year amounted to \$1,100 for our State winner. There is an opportunity to receive up to \$20,000 in the Samsung Scholarship if selected as the National winner. More information and the application can be found at www.legion.org/scholarships/samsung. The 2023 application is available now for completion at http://www.legion.org/samsung-scholarship-application, Note: Please remind students that only COMPLETE ONLINE SUBMISSIONS will be considered, so plan early and make sure the required school official certification form is completed before the end of the school year. Please advise your students that proof of military eligibility by their parents, grandparents, great grandparents or legally adopted parent who served during a period of war is required for the Samsung Scholarship. If the applicant needs to obtain a copy of the veteran's DD Form 214 or proof of service go to the website www.NARA.gov.

Additionally, the MD Boys State program offers opportunity for MD Boys State 2024 graduates to apply for the Robert O. Allen Memorial Scholarships. This scholarship is for \$500.00 and is awarded in June of 2025 to 10 applicants from the 2023 MD Boys State graduating citizens. The application will be available on the MD Boys State website in August 2024.

Posts and districts usually conduct orientations for those selected to attend in the May to early June timeframe, so submission should give sufficient time to process and fund the tuition at the Post for submission to Department Headquarters.

Completed Boys State Application must be received at The American Legion, Department of Maryland Headquarters no later than May 1, 2024.

2024 MD Boys State Agreement of Financial Responsibility in Case of Late Cancellation

MD Boys State is funded by donations from Local Posts and private donors that support our mission of educating future leaders in our community, State, and Nation. In recent years the number of students who cancel their registration for attendance at MD Boys State has increased dramatically. We believe part of this is apathy on the part of the parents and students in notifying us, as there is no cost to the family for a late cancellation. As we do not charge attendees tuition for attendance, and we do not want to establish a deposit system, as this could deter those unable to afford the deposit from attending and is contrary to our mission. We have therefor determined that an agreement between the parents of the applicants and The American Legion, Department of Maryland, Inc. is required to assure timely cancellations, and to reduce fees paid to our host institution for no-shows. This policy shall be enforced by the sponsoring Post or the Department as appropriate in the case of a late cancellation.
