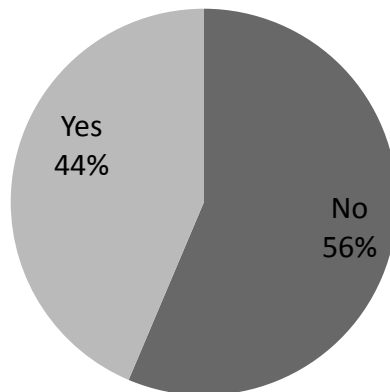




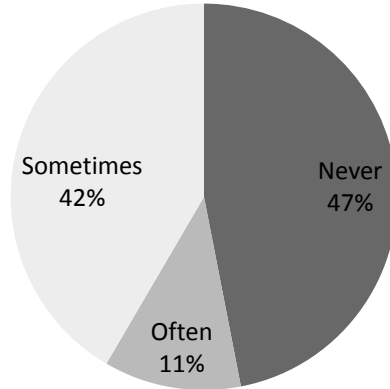
How Frequently Do You Refer to the FCPS CHB Print Copy?



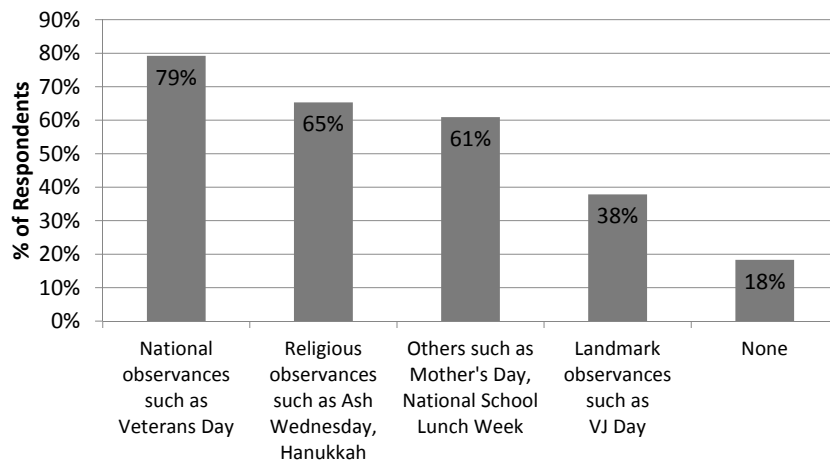
Do You Use the Online Version of the CHB?



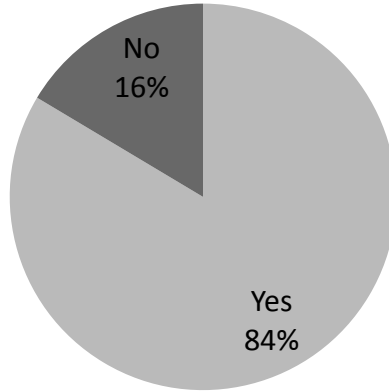
How Often Do You Refer to the CHB Online?



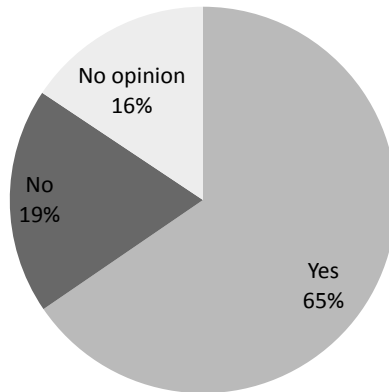
What Observances Do You Want Included in the CHB?



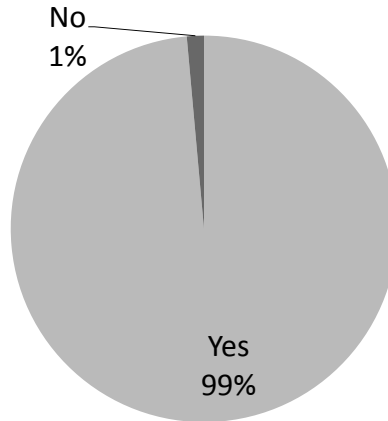
