# Important Dates and Times to Remember

• The official last school day this year for students who attend Frederick County public schools is Wednesday, June 19. On that day, FCPS will dismiss students 2 hours

early for a teacher work session. The last day for 10-month teachers and staff is Thursday, June 20.

- Throughout most of the summer, FCPS schools and offices will operate on a fourday workweek with extended hours Mondays through Thursdays, closed on Fridays. Hours for the Central Office will be 7:30 a.m.-5 p.m. during the four-day summer workweeks. This schedule will take effect the week of June 24. There is an exception the week of Independence Day; Thursday, July 4 is a holiday, and schools and offices will be open regular hours Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday that week.
- The first school day for students is Tuesday, September 3, 2019.
- Be on the lookout for FOF messages over the summer to share updates about Open House and Back to School nights. This information will also be shared in your child's classroom assignment letter, which will be mailed to you in late July.
