- The official last school day this year for students who attend Frederick County public schools is Friday, June 15. On that day, FCPS will dismiss students 2 hours early for a teacher work session. The last day for 10-month teachers and staff is Monday, June 18.
- Throughout most of the summer, FCPS schools and offices will operate on a four-day work-week with extended hours Mondays through Thursdays, closed on Fridays. Hours for the Central Office will be 7:30 a.m.-5 p.m. during the four-day summer workweeks. This schedule will take effect the week of June 18. There is an exception the week of Independence Day; Wednesday, July 4 is a holiday, and schools and offices will be open regular hours Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday that week.
