This scholarship is available to any Frederick County high school senior who has done exemplary community service work and maintains a 3.0 GPA or better. Applicants must complete the attached forms and forward it to Kuehl Scholarship, 10 West 13th Street, Frederick, MD 21701. Applications must be received no later than April 26, 2019 to be considered.
