



## **FREDERICK ASSOCIATION OF SCHOOL SUPPORT EMPLOYEES SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

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The Frederick Association of School Support Employees (FASSE) awards one scholarship each spring to an eligible individual who will attend a university, college or technical school in the fall.

FASSE will award a \$500.00 scholarship at the- end of May 2019.

### **Eligibility**

- Frederick County Public Schools high school seniors whose parent/grandparent/guardian is a current FASSE member.
- Current FASSE members.

### **Criteria for Application Consideration**

- Applicant is enrolled with a two- or four-year college/university/technical school for the fall of 2019.
- If a high school senior, applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better.
- Application is complete and signed upon submission.
- Application is received no later than **noon on Friday, May 10, 2019**. The Scholarship Committee will not consider an application received after this date.

### **Timeline**

- The Scholarship Committee will review applications that meet the stated criteria and select an awardee the week of May 13.
- The Scholarship Committee will notify awardee of selection in writing before the end of May.

### **Application Process**

- Applicant must complete and sign the application form and submit responses to five (5) questions.
- Graduating seniors must provide
  - a copy of an official high school transcript.
  - two (2) letters of recommendation from non-family members; one must come from a Frederick County Public Schools staff member.
- FASSE Support Staff must provide two (2) letters of recommendation from non-family members; one must come from a Frederick County Public Schools supervisor or colleague.
