GENERAL INFORMATION

In accordance with its Americanism Program, Sons of the American Legion Gold Star Squadron 191, Mount Airy, Maryland, awards up to five \$1000.00 Memorial Scholarship Grants to assist youth in furthering their education beyond high school.

These scholarships are earmarked for a recipient in the following order:

- A Gold Star Squadron 191 member in good standing.
- A descendant of a living or deceased member of Gold Start Post 191 Legion, Sons of the American Legion or Auxiliary.
- The son or daughter of a Military person on active duty or of an honorably discharged, separated, or retired U.S. Military veteran.
- A student from the Mount Airy environs.

To be eligible for consideration, an applicant must meet all of the following criteria:

- A citizen of the United States of America who appreciates the value of education and is willing to work hard to achieve success; and
- A graduating high school senior who plans on attending an accredited college, university, or trade school on a full-time basis. Previous scholarship winners attending college may re-apply.
- An applicant must present the completed application **post-marked on or before April 1, 2024.**

THE APPLICATION DEADLINE IS APRIL 1, 2024. THE APPLICATION MUST BE SUBMITTED IN FULL AND MUST BE POSTMARKED BY APRIL 1, 2024, TO BE ELIGIBLE.

PLEASE ENSURE ALL MATERIAL IS INCLUDED IN APPLICATION PACKAGE AND THE APPLICATION IS SIGNED. THE SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE WILL ONLY JUDGE COMPLETED PACKAGES.

<u>Scholastic achievement</u> will constitute a prime criterion by which applicant will be judged. Other criteria which will be taken into consideration include <u>leadership</u>, <u>character</u>, <u>school activities</u>, <u>financial need</u>, <u>work experience</u>, and <u>community service</u>. The decision of the Scholarship Committee is final.

The successful recipient of the scholarship awards will be announced <u>on or about May 1</u>. The grant itself will be made in the name of the recipients to any accredited college or trade school.

Scholarship Items

The following **must be attached** to the 2022 Gold Star Squadron 191 application to be considered for this scholarship or renewal.

- 1. A current **OFFICIAL** high school and/or college transcript in a sealed envelope with an official signature/stamp across the seal.
- 2. Separate list of current extra-curricular activities.
- 3. Three (3) current and signed (within the past 6 months) letters of reference addressed to the SAL 191 Scholarship Committee as to the applicant's character, leadership, and Americanism. One can be from a Principal, Counselor, High School or College Professor (mandatory if in college) and two others from individuals not related to you.) The letters of reference should be in a sealed envelope with the author's signature across the seal.
- 4. An original article (300 words or less) on your chosen career and your aim toward it.
- 5. **Optional**: List of veterans to whom you are related. Please include their branch of service/date of enlistment/date of discharge and any Legion family affiliation.
