

Scholarship Application - 2018
The Thrift Shop at Fort Detrick and Julie Parker Scholarships

The Fort Detrick Thrift Shop is a non-profit private organization. Funds generated by the Thrift Shop are used to support military families, military community organizations, and for the general welfare of the Fort Detrick community. This year, the Thrift Shop Scholarship Committee is responsible for distributing applications, coordinating the selection committee, publicizing, and awarding to qualified applicants the **Thrift Shop at Fort Detrick Scholarship for \$1000.00** and the **Julie Parker Scholarship for \$1000.00**

Eligibility (A STATEMENT OF ELIGIBILITY MUST BE SUBMITTED)

In 2018 only one scholarship application is necessary to be considered for both scholarships.

1. Applicants must be patrons or dependents of patrons eligible to consign items in the Thrift Shop as defined in Article III of the Thrift Shop at Fort Detrick Constitution.
Eligibility for Thrift Shop consignment is:
 - a. Any active duty or retired member of the Armed Forces
 - b. Civilian personnel and contract personnel working at Fort Detrick
 - c. Retired (from Fort Detrick) civilian personnel
2. Must be a current high school senior or an undergraduate student.
3. High school seniors must have made application to an accredited college/university for the fall semester, 2018, and must provide a letter of acceptance. Returning undergraduate students must include a letter from the college or university in which they are enrolled, stating they are in good standing.
4. A scholarship award will be given only once to any one recipient.

Selection Criteria

Selection will be based on overall scholastic achievement, leadership ability, and good citizenship. An independent panel of educators and/or community leaders will evaluate all applicants.

Conditions

The applicant must submit an essay in the space provided on the application form. The essay must be handwritten using the student's own words. The Thrift Shop Scholarship Committee must receive a letter from the Admissions or Finance Officer of the applicable college or university as proof of enrollment for scholarship selectees no later than October 1, 2018.
